

TWINNING AGREEMENT

between

**THE MAYOR AND BURGESSES OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT
(UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND)**

and

**THE CITY OF NABLUS
(PALESTINE)**

This Agreement is between The Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Brent (“Brent Council”) and The City of Nablus, hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties” and singularly referred to as the “Party”.

This is to certify that Brent Council and The City of Nablus hereby agree to the formal twinning which shall commence on the date of execution by the last Party to sign this Agreement and shall continue for a period of five (5) years. The Parties shall review the Agreement prior to its expiry and determine whether the Agreement shall be extended for a further period as agreed to between the Parties.

Purpose of Agreement

The Parties express their commitment to fostering international friendship, mutual understanding and collaboration between Brent and Nablus in a variety of areas such as social and cultural exchanges, education and the arts.

Responsibility for Activities:

The group having responsibility for the twinning activities are:

- Brent Nablus Twinning Association CIC (Company number: 16480094).

The City of Nablus acknowledges and agrees that this Agreement does not create any obligation for Brent Council to provide funding, financial assistance, or any other monetary contribution to the City of Nablus, pursuant to the Brent Nablus International Partnering Protocol Assessment. All activities undertaken pursuant to this Agreement shall be carried out at each Party’s own cost and expense.

Termination and Variation

Either Party may terminate this Agreement by giving three (3) months written notice to the other Party.

Any variations or additions to this Agreement shall be made by mutual written consent and signed by duly authorised representatives of both Parties.

Reviews

The Parties agree that this Agreement will establish a long-term relationship and provisions will be made for regular reviews of the Agreement to ensure continued benefits to both Parties and in accordance with the Brent Council International Partnering Protocol.

This Agreement has been made in both the Arabic and English languages, with both texts being equally authentic.

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. This Agreement shall not take effect until each Party has executed at least one counterpart. The Parties agree that execution and delivery of this Agreement by electronic means (including transmission by email of signed signature pages in PDF format) shall be valid and binding. Each Party may sign on a separate counterpart, and such counterparts together shall form a single agreement.
