- (2) The Council is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out in Manor Close, Kingsbury, NW9, shown outlined in red on the plan attached hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town & Country Planning General Development Orders 1973-1976. _____

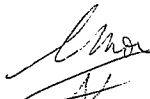
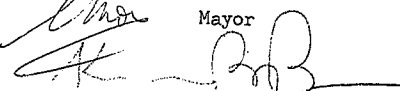

The construction within the curtilage of a dwelling house of a hardstanding for vehicles for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house as such, being development within Class I 4 referred to in the First Schedule of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order 1973 and not being development comprised within any other Class. _____
