
Why should you start your teaching career in Brent?

Newly Qualified Teachers (NQTs) will gain lots of experience of teaching EAL learners - the job satisfaction this brings is enormous for the following reasons:

- 1) Our EAL learners blossom and make faster progress than others
- 2) Teaching EAL learners does not require a mysterious magic formula – it's about infusing all your teaching with opportunities to broaden and deepen vocabulary and understanding
