

WHEREAS:-

- (1) The Council of the London Borough of Brent (hereinafter called "The Council") is the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of the Town & Country Planning Acts 1971-1974.
- (2) The Council is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out in Manor Close, Kingsbury, NW9, shown outlined in red on the plan attached hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town & Country Planning General Development Orders 1973-1976.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them

by Article 4 of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order

And Anticle 4 of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order

1973/ hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 of the

said Order shall not apply to development in Manor Close of the

description set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The construction within the curtilage of a dwelling house of a hardstanding for vehicles for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwelling house as such, being development within Class I 4 referred to in the First Schedule of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order 1973 and not being development comprised within any other Class.
