



## **Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations**

The London Borough of Brent is carrying out a review of all its polling districts, polling places and polling stations. As part of the review, the (Acting) Returning Officer for Brent Council must comment on proposed polling stations in the borough and her views are available for anyone to inspect at Brent Civic Centre or at [www.brent.gov.uk/pdreview](http://www.brent.gov.uk/pdreview)

Any elector in the borough of Brent or within a parliamentary constituency wholly or partly situated in the borough may make a representation to the Council on the layout of polling districts and the location of polling places. The Council welcomes the views of all residents on these proposals. The Council also invites any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment.

Any person or bodies making comments should, wherever possible, make alternative proposals or suggest locations that may be used as polling places or polling stations.
