WHAT ARE THE RULES FOR SOAPBOX?

In order that everyone gets the same opportunity and that no offence is caused to any member of the Forum audience, certain ground rules will apply and we would ask everyone who participates to respect them.

SOAPBOX topics or issues discussed must be relevant to the Area and its communities, and can be of a social, economic or environmental nature. Equal Opportunities guidelines will be applied and no inappropriate topics or comments will be allowed. Three minutes maximum will be allowed for each slot, and the Chair will monitor timekeeping. If appropriate, the Council will provide a response, either on the night, or in writing at a later date.
