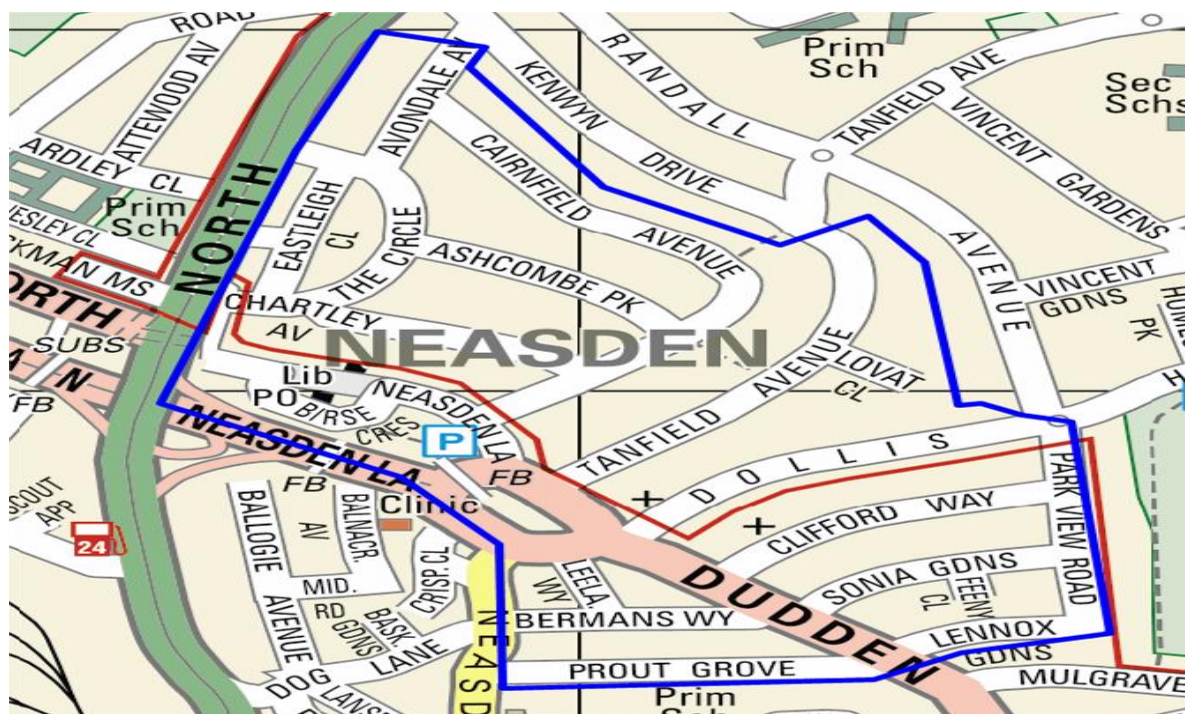
ANTI-SOCIAL CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014
Section 59

Neasden Public Spaces Protection Order

The London Borough of Brent, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of three (3) years a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area (outlined on the map below) where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer (where accredited) or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area

From Prout Grove heading east crossing Dudden Hill Lane along Lennox Gardens to jct Park View Road, heading north along Park View Road crossing Dollis Hill then continuing along Cairnfield Avenue to jct Avondale Avenue crossing Avondale Avenue to meet North Circular Road A406, then heading south to jct with Neasden Lane, along Neasden Lane to jct with Prout Grove. This includes any roads, open spaces, communal spaces within the mapped outlined area.



Relevant Period

From (time)	0001	hrs (24 hour clock) on	3 September	(year)	2018
To (time)	2359	hrs (24 hour clock) on	2 September	(year)	2021

PROHIBITIONS

Within the area described below, the following is prohibited:-

- 1) To operate a transport service without the written authority of Transport for London or the London Borough of Brent by means of coach, minibus or other similar conveyance which terminates or stops within the restricted area and in so doing is likely to cause nuisance, annoyance or harassment to others by reason of numbers of persons or vehicles congregating, inconsiderate positioning of vehicles or other similar behaviour.

BREACH OF PSPO

Failure to comply with PSPO prohibitions is a criminal offence subject to up to a level 3 fine on prosecution (up to £1000). A warning will be issued upon the first instance of a breach. Further breach will result in the issuing of a Fixed Penalty Notice (£100), payable within 14 days. If paid within 10 days, a discounted charge of £75 is applied. Payment of the Fixed Penalty Notice discharges liability to conviction for the offence. A notice will be displayed in the affected area announcing the end of the authority when it no longer applies.
