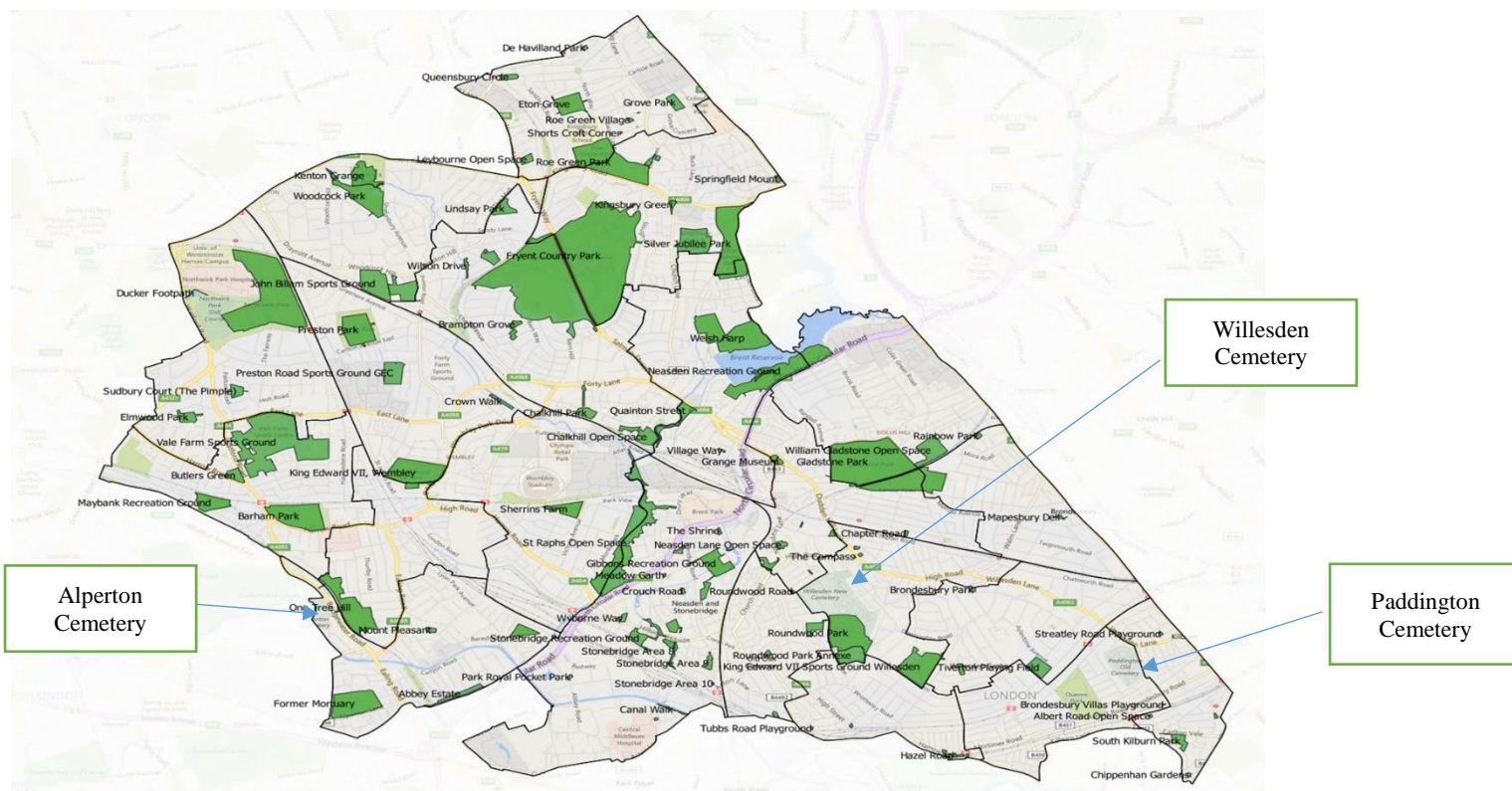
Section 59

Public Spaces Protection Order Parks, Open Spaces Graveyards and Cemeteries

The London Borough of Brent, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of 3 years a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area (outlined on the map below) where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer (where accredited) or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area:

LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT



From (time)	0001	hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	17 September	(year)	2019
To (time)	2359	hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	16 September	(year)	2022

PROHIBITIONS:

Within the area described, the following are prohibited: -

1. Use of illegal drugs or psychoactive substances (formerly known as legal highs).
2. Consumption of alcohol:
 - To be prohibited in Butlers Green, One Tree Hill, Gladstone Park, Roundwood Park and Barn Hill Open Space
3. Littering (such as cigarettes, bottles, cans, packets, food).
4. Urinating or defecating in a place other than a serviced public convenience.
5. Use of motor vehicles without the written consent of the London Borough of Brent unless in cemeteries where motor vehicles access is permitted.
6. Defacing or damaging fixtures, furniture or other items.
7. Losing control of any dogs.
 - where a dog is not reasonably within eyesight of the owner and where a dog does not respond to being beckoned by the owner.
- a. Should an authorised officer request a dog should be put on a lead in all parks, open spaces, graveyards and cemeteries, failure to comply is a breach of the PSPO.
8. Letting a dog enter an area where a notice specifies that dogs are not allowed, such as a playground.
9. Walking more than 4 dogs at a time.
10. Flying of drones or any other form of model aircraft without the written consent of the London Borough of Brent.
11. Launching sky lanterns that "rely on an open flame to heat the air inside the lantern"
12. Lighting of fires or using barbeques.
13. Use of fireworks without the written consent of the London Borough of Brent.

REQUIREMENTS

Within the area described, the following are required: -

14. In the event that a dog defecates, the person responsible for the dog at the time must remove the faeces immediately.
15. Dogs must be kept on a lead in multi-use games areas (MUGA), tennis courts, walled gardens, and areas where a notice specifies that dogs must be on a lead.

BREACH OF PSPO

Failure to comply with PSPO prohibitions is a criminal offence subject to up to a level 3 fine on prosecution (up to £1000). A warning will be issued upon the first instance of a breach. Further breach will result in the issuing of a Fixed Penalty Notice (£100), payable within 14 days. If paid within 10 days, a discounted charge of £75 is applied. Payment of the Fixed Penalty Notice discharges liability to conviction for the offence. **A notice will be displayed in the affected area announcing the end of the authority when it no longer applies.
