
## Section 59

### Area Surrounding Wembley Stadium Public Spaces Protection Order

The London Borough of Brent, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, will on 1 January 2020 for a duration of 3 years establish a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area (outlined in red on the map below) where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer (where accredited) or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

#### Restricted area

All areas contained within the following; from the junction of Drury Way along the railway line to Bridge Road, towards Empire Way to junction of Wembley Park Drive. From Empire Way including Wembley Hill Road, Park Place, Dagmar Avenue continuing south to Wembley Hill Road leading to High Road including Central Square and parts of Harrow Road, continuing from junction of Wembley Hill Road along South Way, Great Central Way back to the junction of Drury Way.



#### Prohibitions

From 00:01 hours on 1 January 2020 to 23:59 hours on 31 December 2022

**Within the restricted area described above, the following are prohibited: -**

1. To engage in illegal street trading which includes the buying and/or selling of any item(s) including tickets (ticket touting) to any person.
2. To consume alcohol or having an open alcohol container in a public space, who without reasonable excuse continues consuming alcohol or fails to surrender the alcohol in his/her possession when asked to do so by a Police Officer or authorised Council officer.
3. To distribute free literature which includes leaflets, the giveaway of free samples etc. without authorisation from the London Borough of Brent
4. To litter (such as cigarettes, bottles, cans, packets, food, urination,) etc.
5. To fly drone(s) without written consent from the land owner and/or the London Borough of Brent
6. To fly-post, which has potential to deface or damage fixtures, furniture or any other items.
7. To let off fireworks, including flares and smoke emitters in a public place, which may cause a nuisance and panic.
8. To play games or competitions which may cause an obstruction or nuisance to members of the public.
9. To undertake busking and use of loud speakers causing a nuisance without authorisation from the landowner and/or the London Borough of Brent.
10. To leave the engine of a vehicle idling without reasonable excuse, which is continued when asked to be stopped by an authorised Council officer.
11. To undertake Charity Collections without the consent from London Borough of Brent.

#### Breach of PSPO

Failure to comply with PSPO prohibitions is a criminal offence subject to up to a level 3 fine on prosecution (up to £1000). A warning will be issued upon the first instance of a breach. Further breach will result in the issuing of a Fixed Penalty Notice (£100), payable within 14 days. If paid within 10 days, a discounted charge of £75 is applied. Payment of the Fixed Penalty Notice discharges liability to conviction for the offence. A notice will be displayed in the affected area announcing the end of the authority when it no longer applies.
