












## What are Moving Traffic Contraventions?

Moving Traffic Contraventions are listed in the Highway Code. They include making banned turns, weight restrictions and restrictions around entering a box junction.

Here is a list including descriptions of possible Moving Traffic Contraventions and their relevant traffic signs:

Description of traffic sign	Sign
Vehicular traffic must proceed in the direction indicated by the arrow	
Vehicular traffic must turn ahead in the direction indicated by the arrow.	
Vehicular traffic must comply with the requirements prescribed in regulation 15.	
No right turn for vehicular traffic	
No left turn for vehicular traffic	
No U turns for vehicular traffic	
Priority must be given to vehicles from the opposite direction	 
No entry for vehicular traffic	
All Vehicles prohibited except non – mechanically propelled vehicles being pushed by pedestrians	 

Entry to pedestrian zone restricted (Alternative types)	
Entry to and waiting in pedestrian zone restricted (Alternative types)	
Entry to and waiting in pedestrian zone restricted (Variable message sign)	
Motor vehicles prohibited	
Motor vehicles except solo motorcycles prohibited	
Solo motorcycles prohibited	
Goods vehicles exceeding the maximum gross weight indicated on the goods vehicle symbol prohibited	
One way traffic	
Route for use by buses and pedal cycles only	
Route for use by tramcars only	
Part of the Carriageway outside a school entrance where vehicles should not stop.	
Marking Conveying the requirements prescribed in regulation 29(2) and Part II of Schedule 19 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
